Is Nursing a passion in your life? Do you want to work with a team that *truly* makes a difference in the everyday lives of others? St. Louis Developmental Disabilities Treatment Centers (SLDDTC) is currently recruiting to fill a full-time Registered Nurse position at our St. Charles Habilitation Center. We are recruiting for an opening on Team II. The working hours are 2:30 pm to 11:00 pm. Days off are alternating Tuesday/Thursdays and every other weekend. The qualified candidate will provide care to consumers with feeding tubes, in need of wound care treatments, and tracheotomy care, thus a medical surgical background is preferred.

SLDDTC is a 24-hour residential care facility that provides medical, behavioral and habilitation support to individuals with developmental disabilities. We offer an excellent benefits package.

The primary duties assigned to this Registered Nurse position include, working with a team of other nurses to plan, supervise and participate in providing nursing care and treatment for individuals who have developmental disabilities; conducting Nursing assessments and developing Nursing diagnoses and care plans; assisting in training and mentoring Licensed Practical Nurses and/or Agency Nurses and evaluating their work performances; giving medications and treatments as prescribed by a Physician; making rounds and informing Physicians of the status of the individuals who reside with us; maintaining clinical charts; and preparing related health status reports. Work is reviewed by Senior Nursing staff and Physicians to conform effectiveness of Nursing activities and compliance with established Policies and accepted Nursing standards of practice; however, as the employee gains on the job training and experience and becomes more familiar with the residents in their assigned unit or assignment, work is performed with more independence within established Nursing standards and procedures.

Experience and Education Qualifications: Graduate of an accredited nursing program: Possession of a current license to practice as a Registered Nurse in Missouri.

This position will be covered by the Missouri Merit System. A copy of a Missouri Merit System application can be obtained from the Missouri Office of Administration Personnel Division at <http://www.EASE.mo.gov>. Applicants are responsible for immediately requesting merit system application forms and for providing required application materials directly to the Office of Administration. Current state employees must have be free from formal discipline for six months and have a good attendance record.
