Is nursing a passion in your life? Do you want to make a difference in people's lives on a daily basis? Do you want to know that your work has meaning? St. Louis Developmental Disabilities Treatment Centers (SLDDTC) is currently recruiting to fill a Registered Nurse Supervisor position at our South County Habilitation Center. Work schedule is 2:30pm to 11:00pm. For the initial training period regular days off will be Saturday/Sunday; after the initial training period the regular days off will be alternating Tuesday/Thursday schedule with every other weekend off. (Hours and regular days off are subject to change to meet facility needs.) This position also requires sharing on call responsibilities as needed. SLDDTC is a 24-hour residential care facility that provides medical, behavioral and habilitation support to individuals with developmental disabilities.

This is an advanced professional and supervisory, educational position. The primary duties assigned are coordinating directing, evaluating and participating in the nursing care of physically or mentally ill or disabled clients. Applicants in this class normally are responsible for all nursing services in a moderate-sized multi-ward unit. The applicant serves as the facility-wide nursing supervisor on an assigned shift. Applicant may also function in an educational or administrative capacity in areas such as nursing, staff development, quality assurance, utilization review, employee health, infection control, etc. The applicant will be expected to work independently with a minimum of supervision. Work will be reviewed by the supervisor for conformance with established policies and nursing procedures. Applicant will direct and evaluate nursing services provided in a small facility, may function as a facility-wide shift supervisor: direct and supervise the work of subordinate professional and paraprofessional nurses. Review nursing assessment, diagnoses and care plans and evaluates effectiveness of nursing. Make rounds of units, provide specialized clinical nursing services in specific areas, develop nursing plans, direct and evaluate nursing in-service and training program under the Director of Nursing. Applicant must have full knowledge of professional nursing theory, practices and standards, and also have the ability to direct, supervise and evaluate nursing functions of patient/client care and staff relationships. Applicant must be able to develop and maintain an empathetic attitude to the physically or mentally ill or disabled and their families. Successful candidate must be able to develop and maintain a positive working relationship with peers, superiors and subordinates.

Experience and Education Requirements: a Master's degree in Nursing from an accredited college or university and one or more years of professional experience as a Registered Nurse; OR a Bachelor's degree in Nursing from an accredited college or university and two or more years of professional experience as a Registered Nurse; OR an Associate's degree in Nursing from an accredited college or university or a Diploma in Nursing and three or more years of professional experience as a Registered Nurse.

Special Requirement: Possession of a current license to practice as a Registered Nurse in the State of Missouri.

Current state employees must have a good attendance record, and be free from formal discipline for twelve months.
