South County Habilitation Center currently has an opening for a Registered Nurse/Registered Nurse Senior to work within the Nursing Department. Working hours are 2:30p.m. to 11:00p.m. with alternating Tuesday/Thursday and every other weekend off. This is entry to senior level professional nursing work that is responsible for planning and participating in the nursing care of persons with developmental disabilities.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to: Provide general nursing care, perform nursing assessments, may function as the nurse in charge of an assigned shift, develop individualized treatment plans, etc.

The ideal candidate should have the professional knowledge of nursing theory, practices and standards to ensure that all clinical charts and reports are kept current on the progress and status of patients. Working knowledge of management principles and techniques applied to the administration of nursing is needed.

Eligibility:

Must possess a current license to practice as a Registered Nurse in the State of Missouri or in accordance with Missouri's Nurse Licensure Compact at the time of appointment.

To qualify as a Registered Nurse Senior, candidate must have possession of a Master's degree in Nursing OR a Bachelor's degree in Nursing with a minimum of one year of professional experience as a Registered Nurse OR an Associate's degree in Nursing with two or more years of professional experience as a Registered Nurse.
