

The Oregon Office of Developmental Disabilities strives to support individuals with disabilities and their families within communities by providing services that are person-centered, flexible, community inclusive, and supportive of each individual's unique gifts, talents and abilities. This position administers the Stabilization and Crisis Unity (SACU) operated by ODDS. SACU is a 24/7 residential program for 85 adults and 15 children with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (I/DD) with significant support needs. SACU primarily supports people who are dually diagnosed with I/DD and mental health needs. There are over 15 homes in 7 counties and approximately 780 state employed staff.

The SACU Director must assure that health safety and service outcomes are met for people living in SACU homes, manage direct care staffing, work with county partners and Union leaders. The Director provides oversight of all aspects of SACU operational regulatory requirements as a state operated Home and Community Based setting for people with I/DD. The position provides budget, personnel and management oversight.

### **ABOUT THE PROGRAM**

SACU is a 24/7 residential program for 85 adults and 15 children most of whom are dually diagnosed with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities, and mental health needs. ODDS is actively searching for a Director who will have the following responsibilities:

- Provide leadership to SACU
- Provide direct supervision to 7 managers
- Directly oversee 56 management positions and 689 represented staff in SACU located across the state with two unions
- Develop and implement staffing model, monitor position management
- Develop and implement policies and procedures that guide staff work and staff training
- Provide oversight of the clinical team on professional behavioral practices, the Oregon Intervention System (OIS), and nursing practices.
- Work with ODDS field unit staff and county DD management on programs and client needs including exit and entrances
- Represent SACU and DHS in county level meetings and legislative meetings as requested by the ODDS Director
- Develop and monitor budgets, by provider group homes and across the agency for SACU
- Provide ongoing reports on budget, client outcomes, program profiles and staffing issues to DHS and ODDS executive management teams
